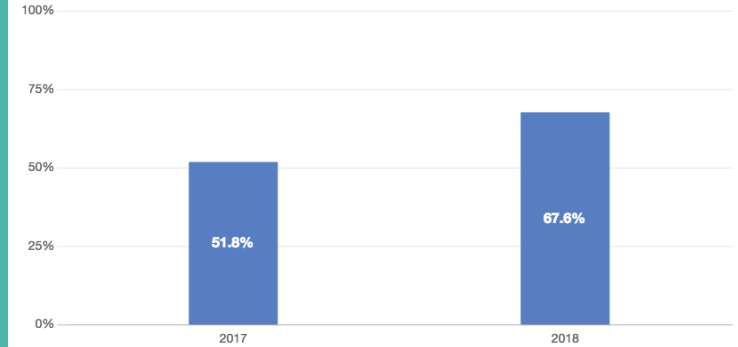

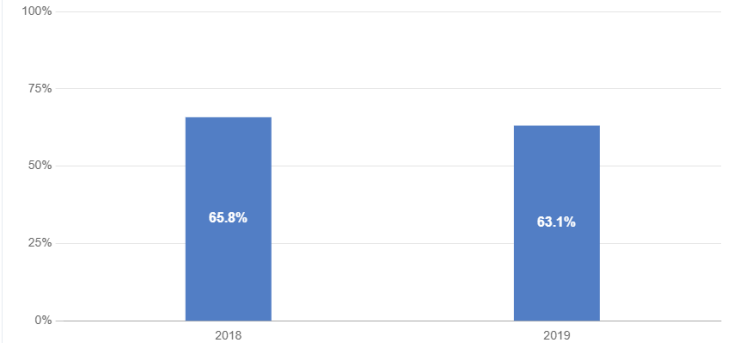
Graduation Rate By Year

Percentage of students who received a high school diploma within four years of entering ninth grade or complete their graduation requirements at an alternative school.

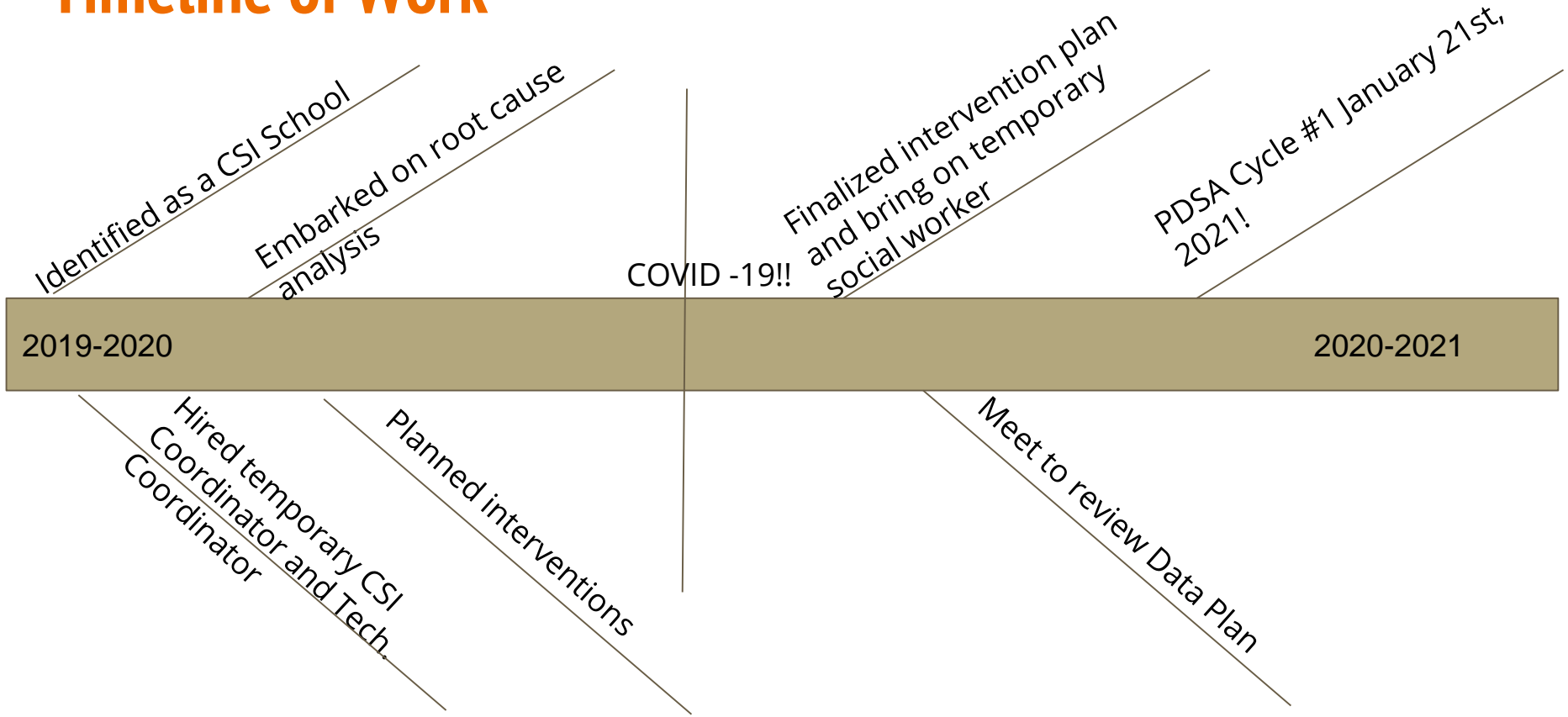


Graduation Rate By Year

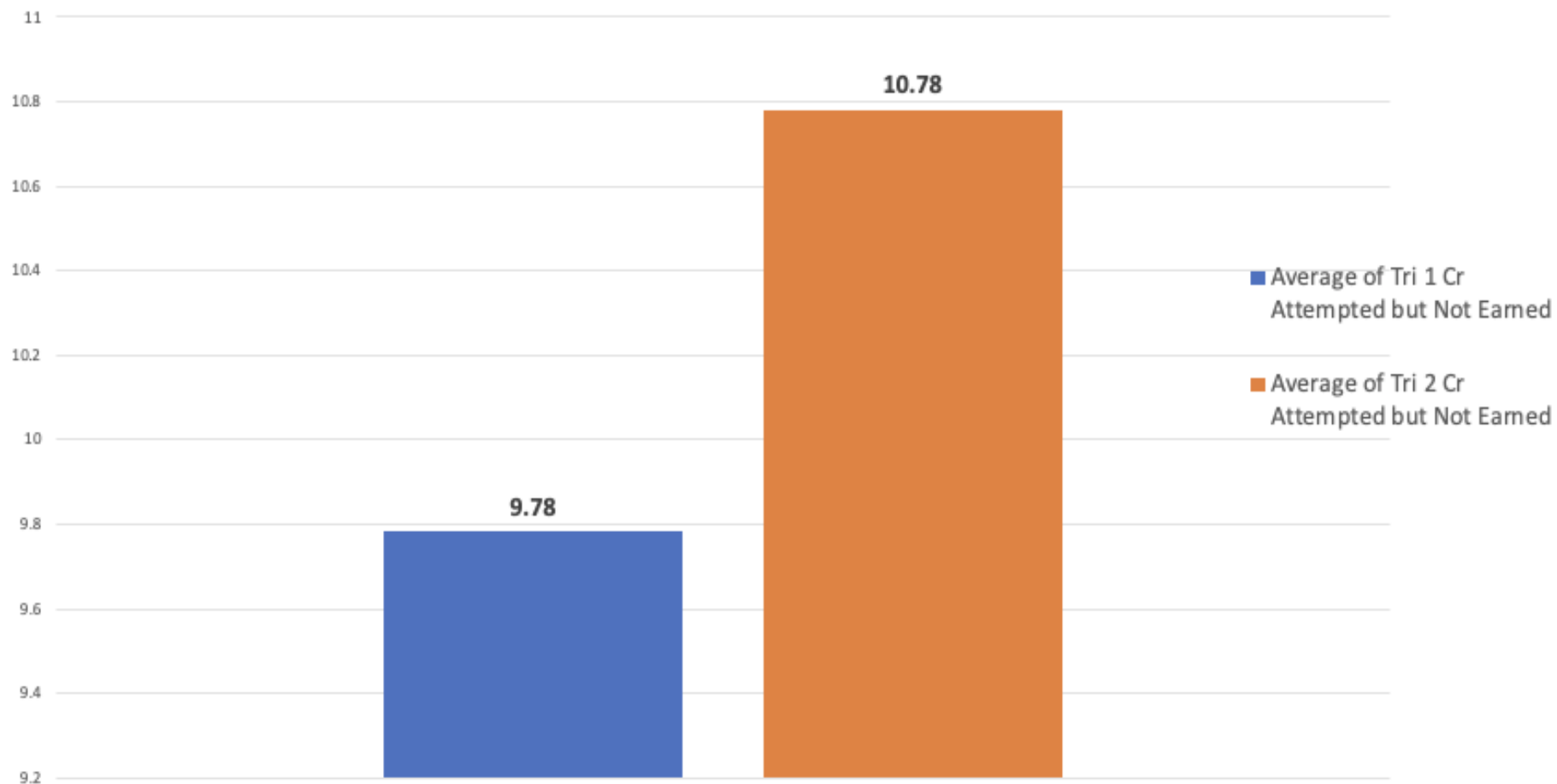


Root Cause Analysis and Hypothesis

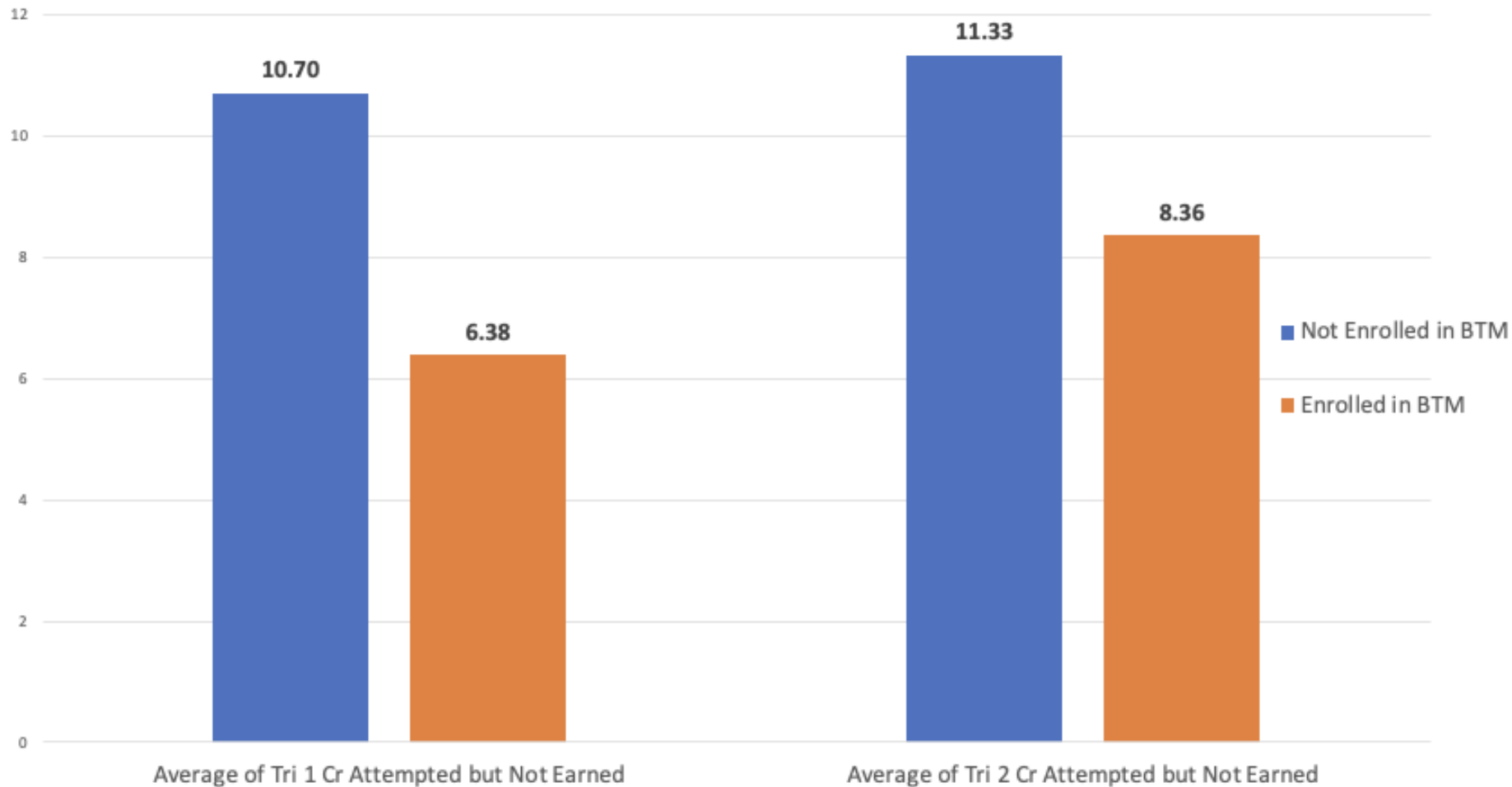
Hypothesis	Change Idea	Data to Monitor Effectiveness
Based on attendance data, correlations to graduation rate, and empathy interview data, we believe that Ivy students who are not finding success are mis-identifying anxiety symptoms as illness, and if we address social emotional challenges of students, attendance will increase, which in turn will spark an increase in graduation rate. Average Number of Credits Attempted but not Earned Trimesters 1 and 2

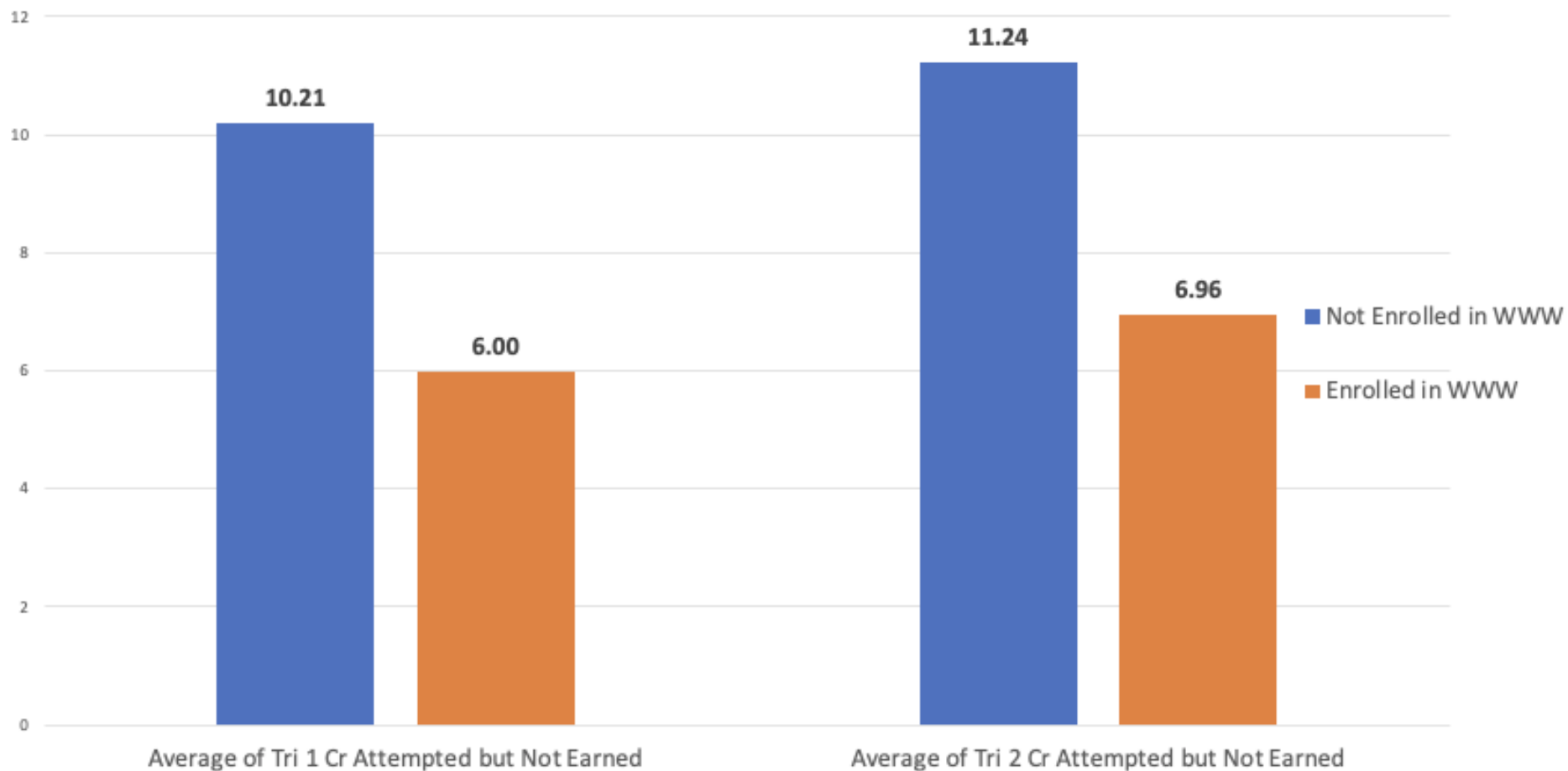
Average Trimester 1 & 2 Credits Attempted but Not Earned for All Students



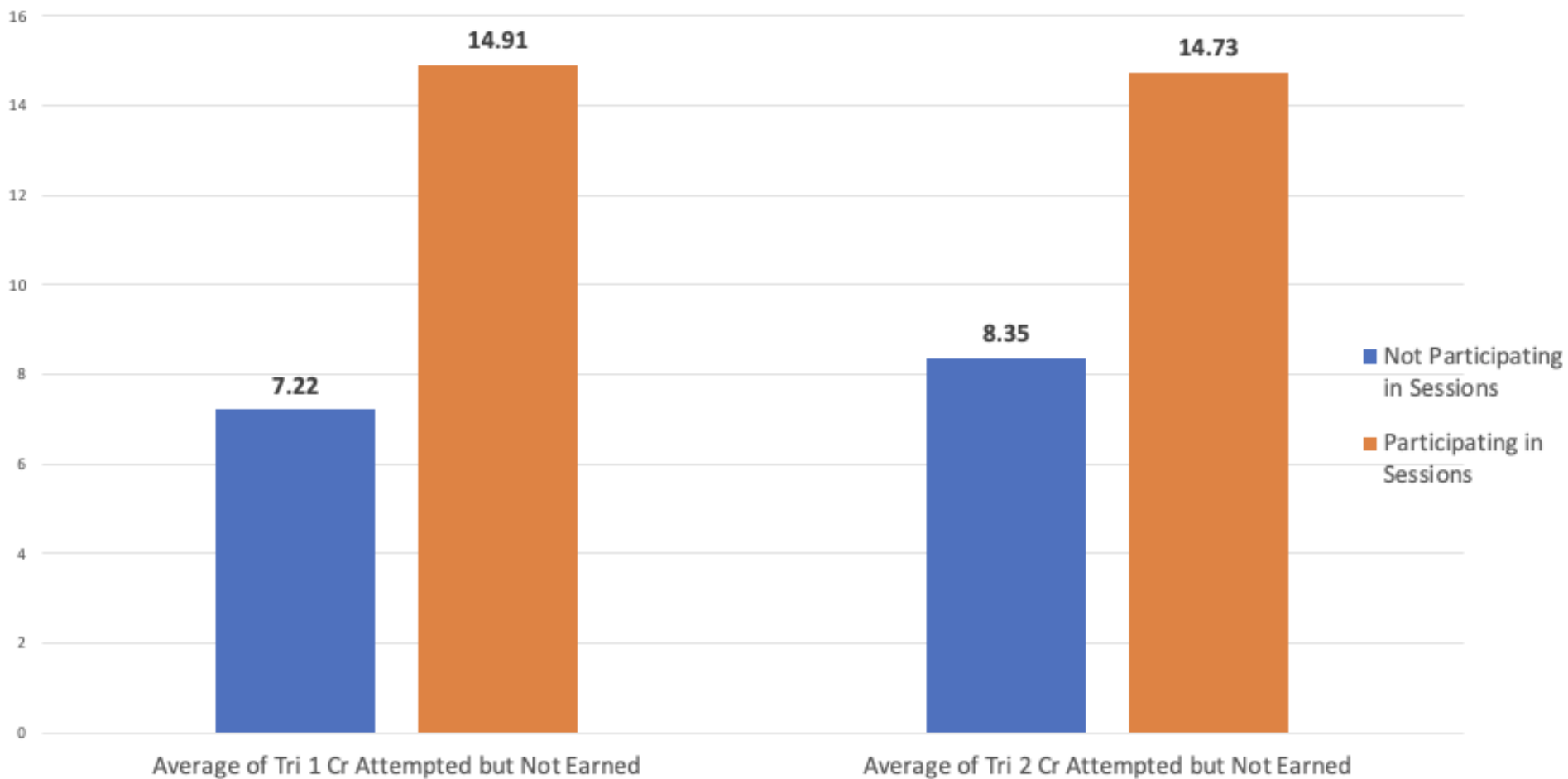
Enrollment in Boys to Men & Trimester 1 & 2 Credits



Enrollment in WWW & Trimester 1 & 2 Credits

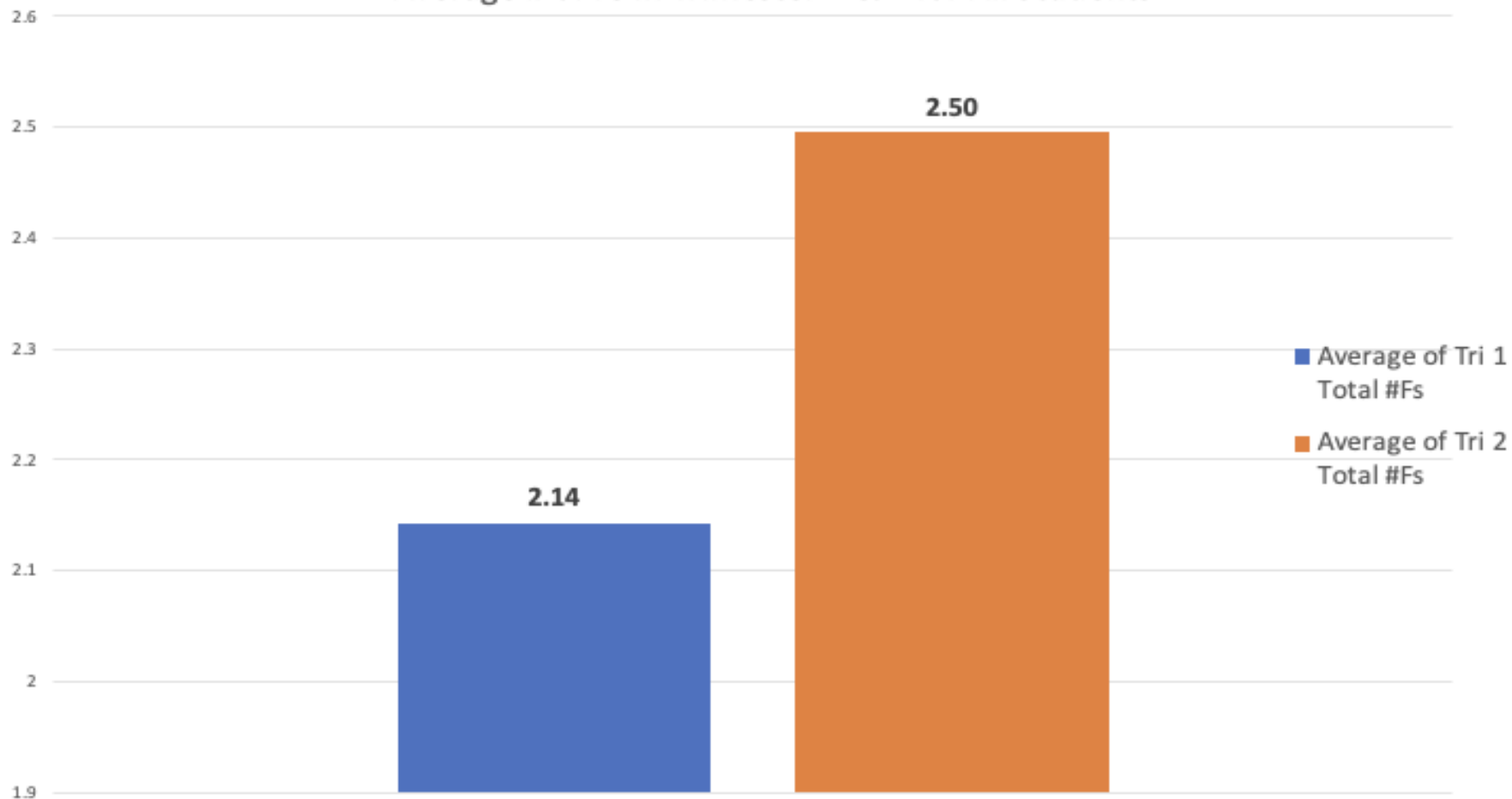

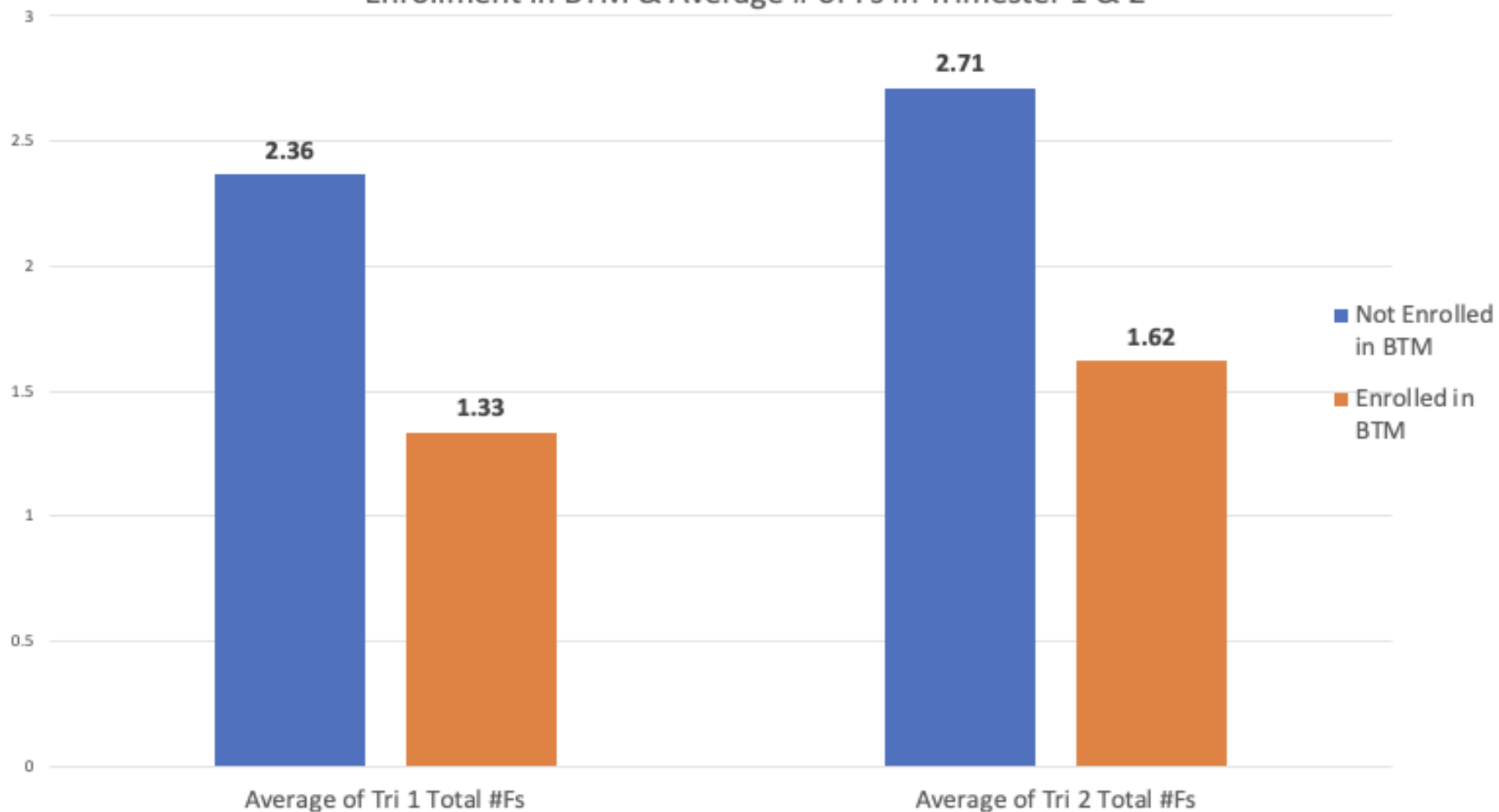


Average Number of Fs Trimesters 1 and 2

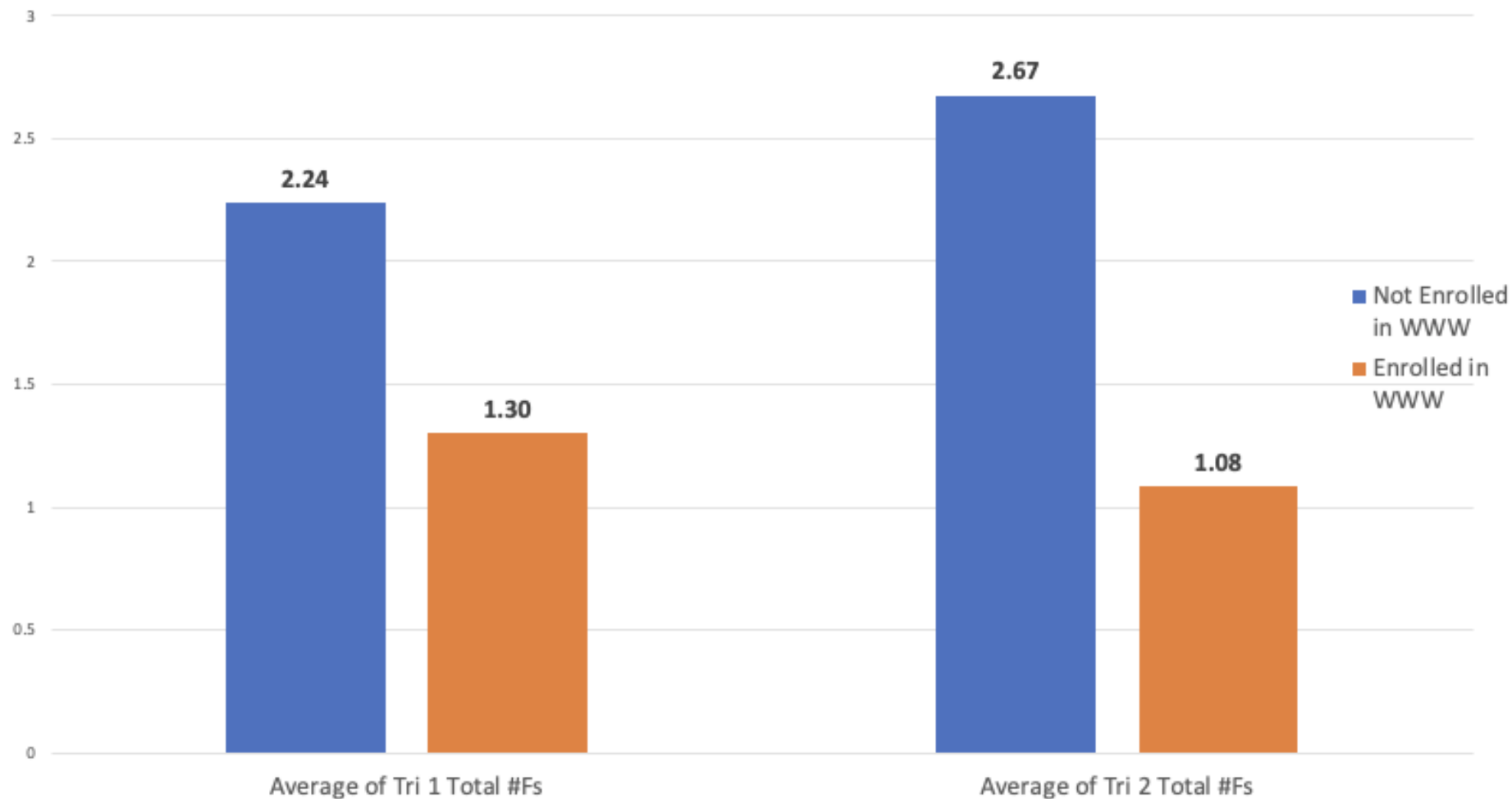
Average # of Fs in Trimester 1 & 2 for All Students



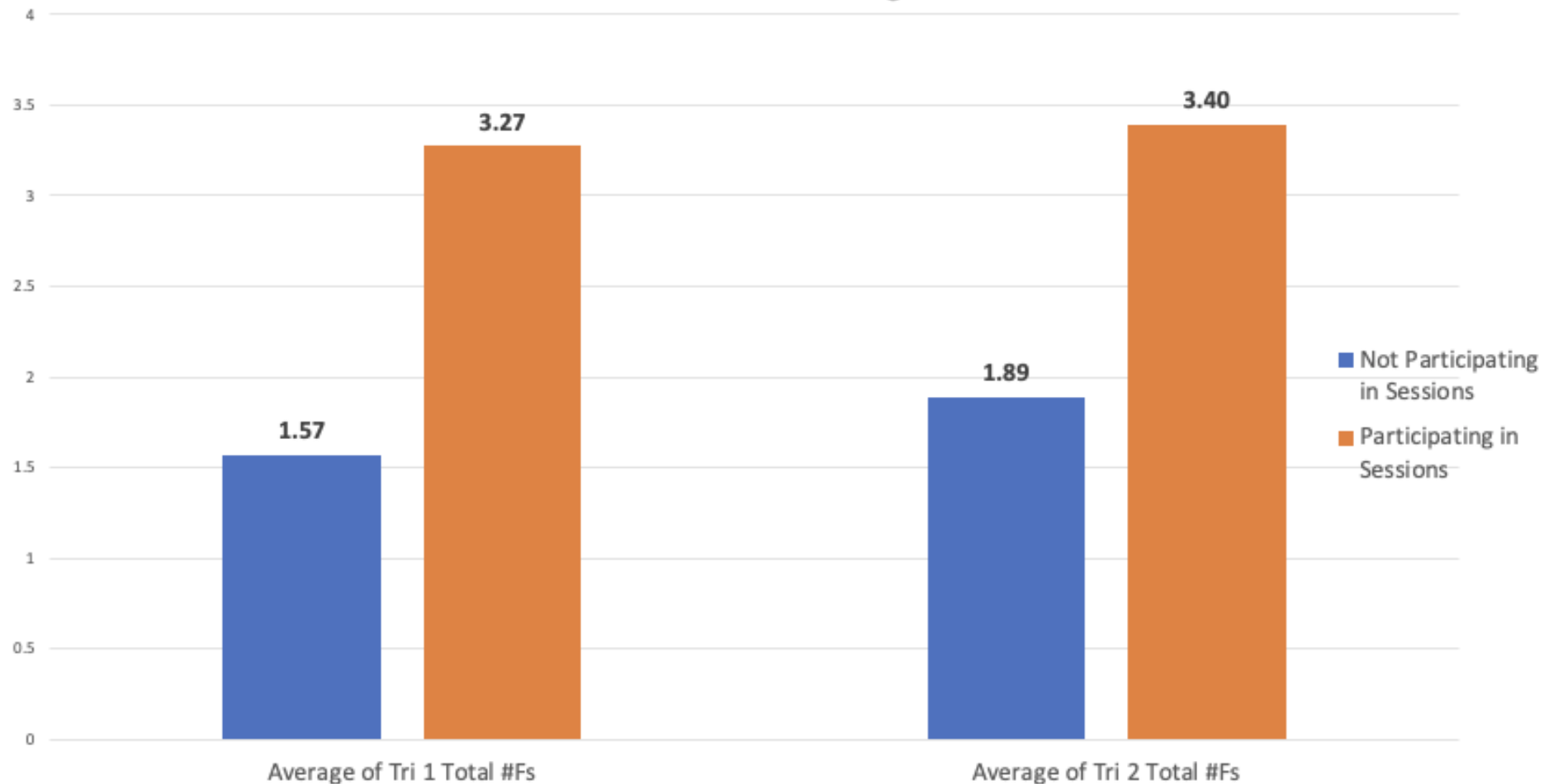
Enrollment in BTM & Average # of Fs in Trimester 1 & 2



Enrollment in WWW & Average # of Fs in Trimester 1 & 2



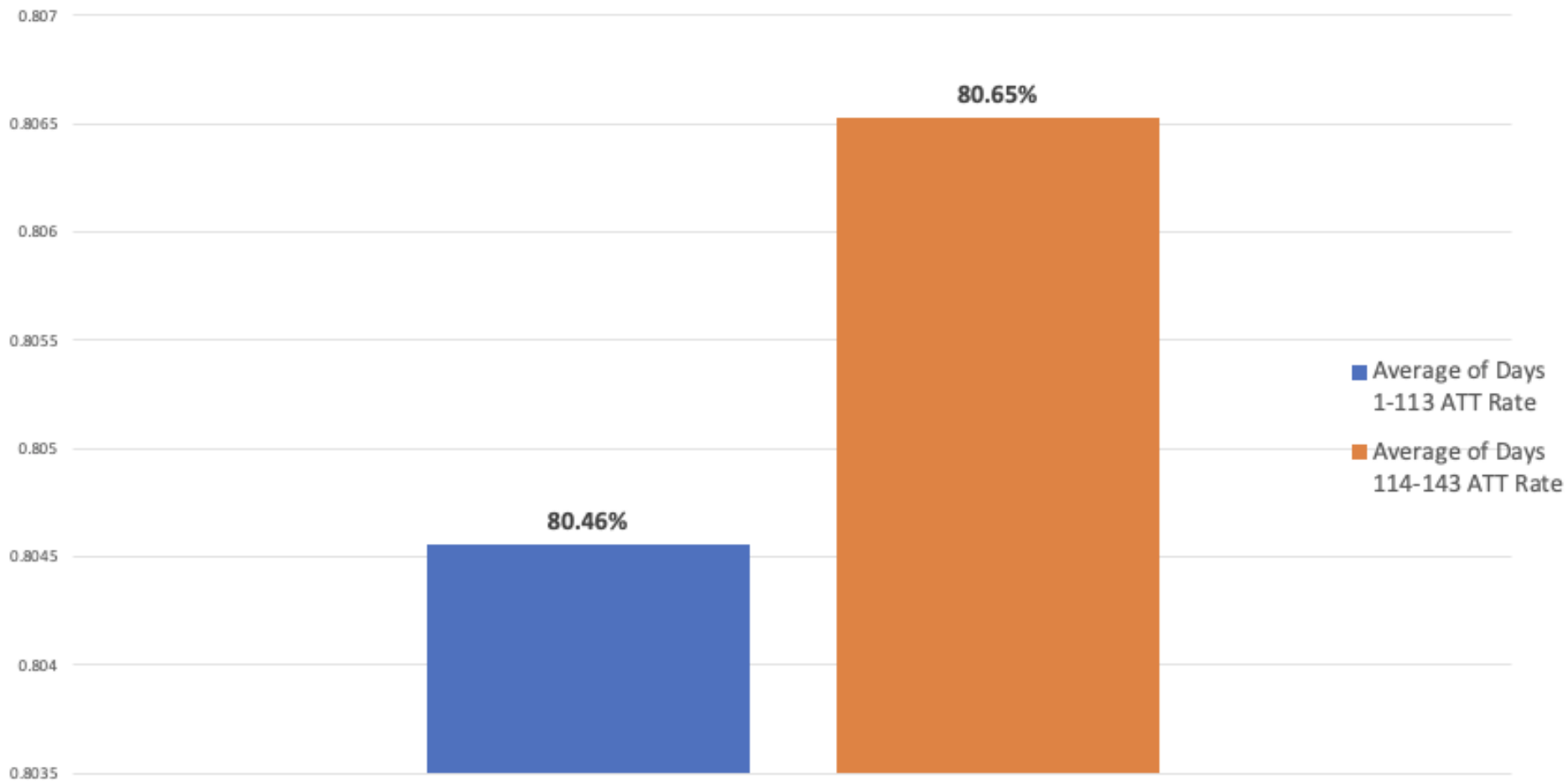

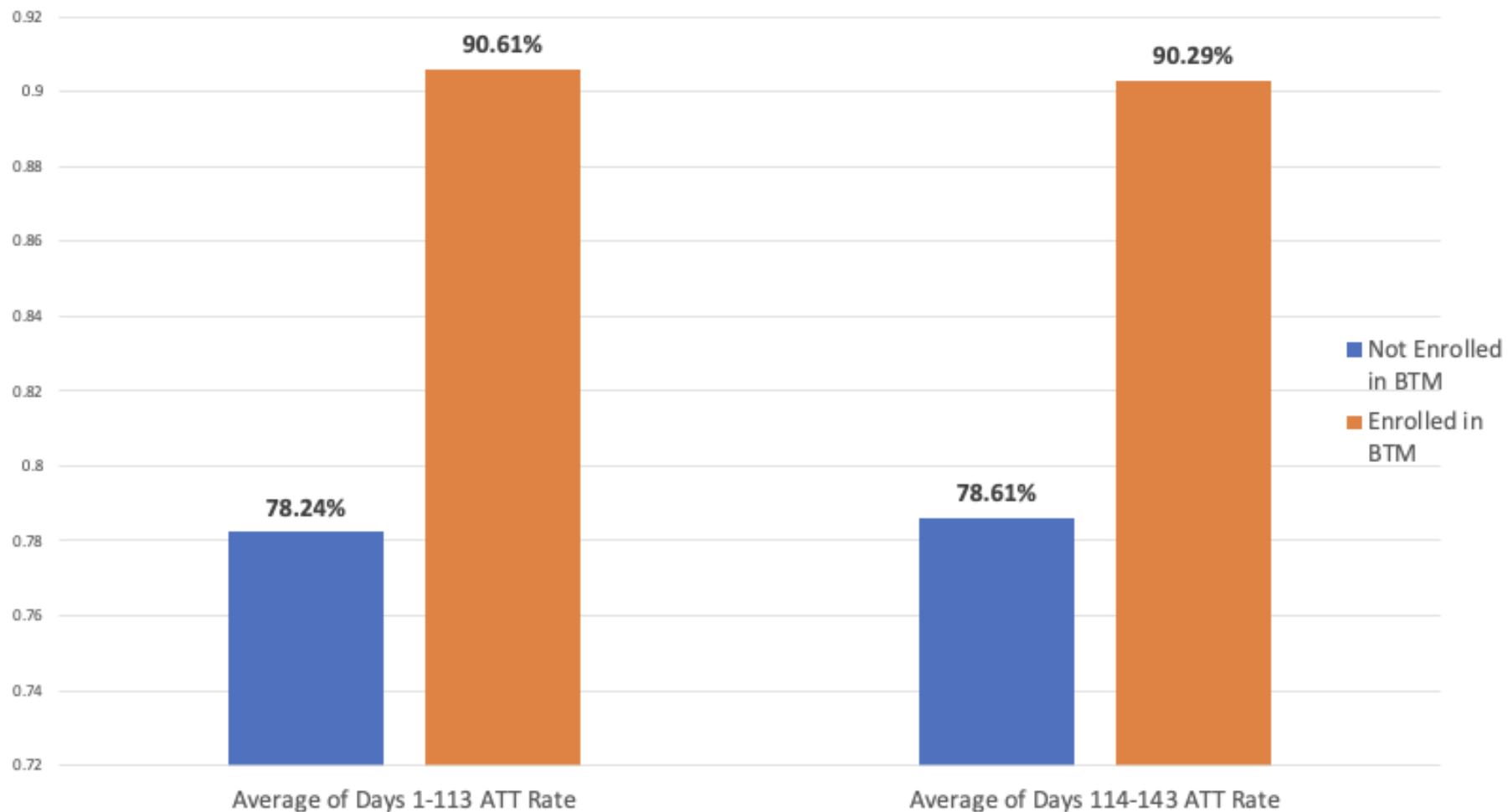

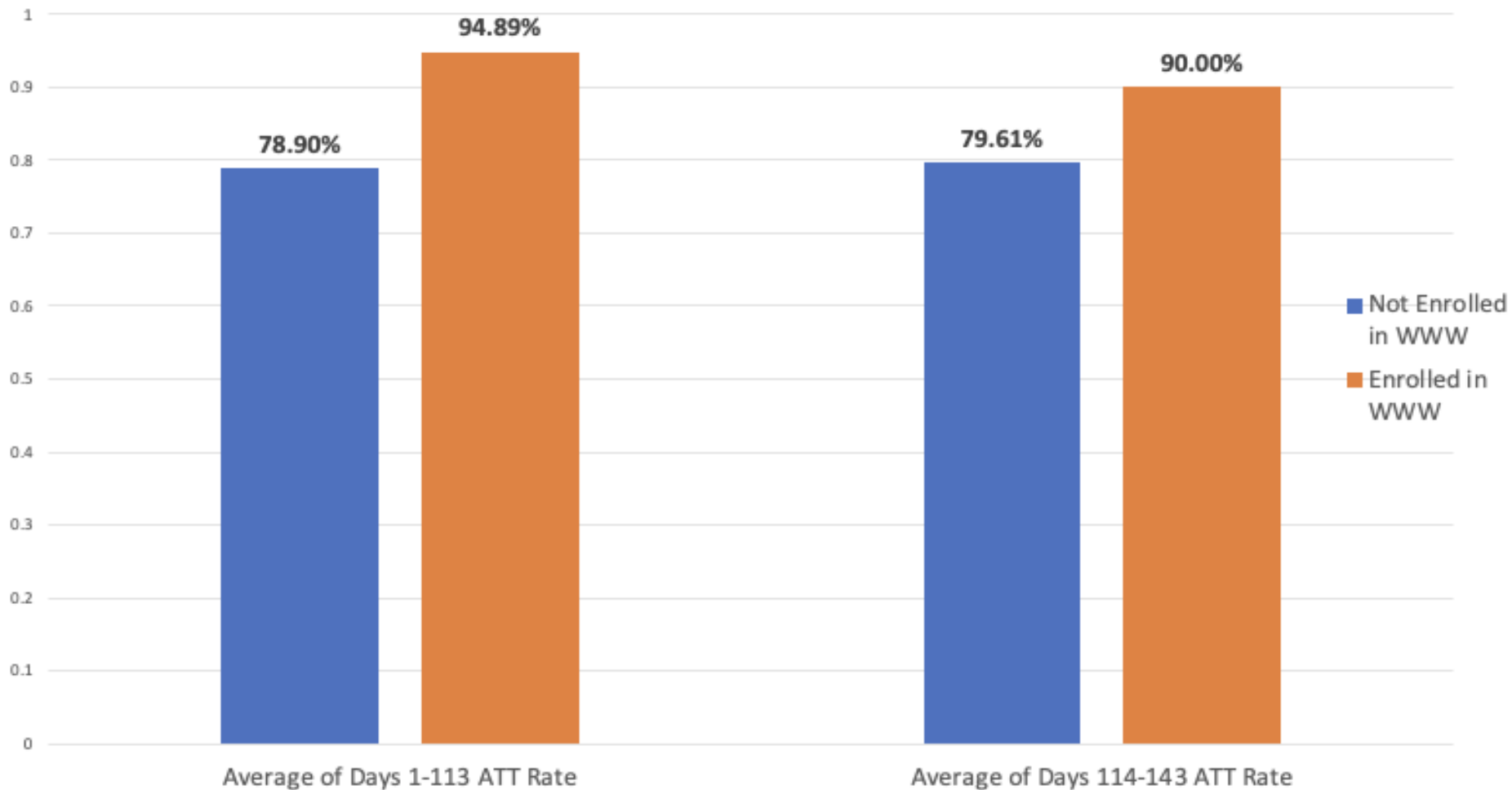
Average Attendance Rates for All Students
