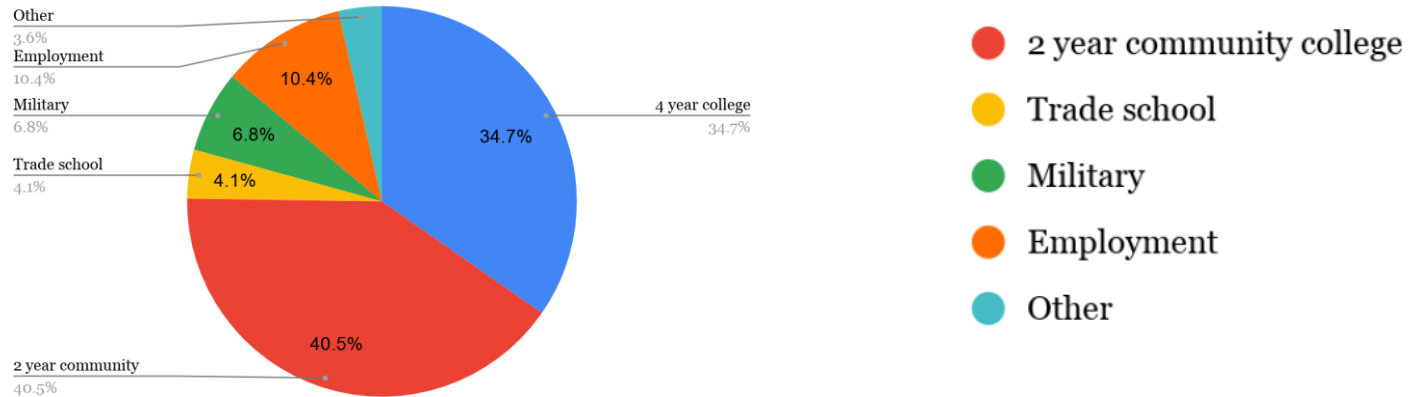

 - **Conducting conferences with parents, students and teachers to discuss graduation issues that may be impacting academic success**

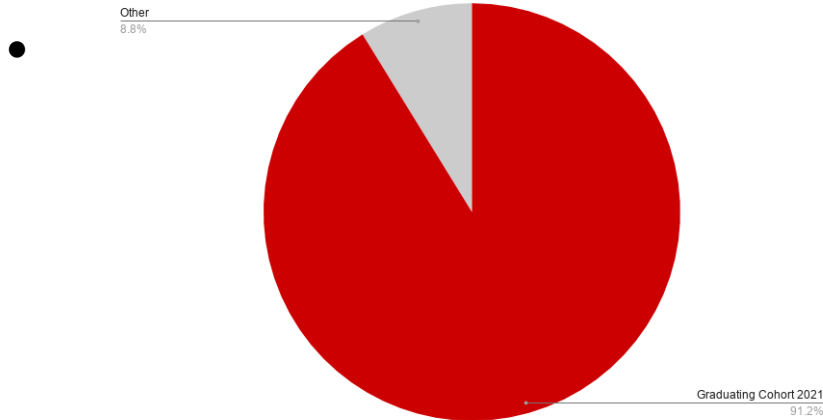
GENERAL UPDATES
